

Choosing care accommodation (cont'd)

Steps	Activity	Action
Options	<p>Identify care accommodation options.</p> <p>The options include: a private home, portioning of a family home, seeking government or private funding, a support network and financial assets.</p> <p>Understand the nature and type of services and consider the suitability of the individual service providers.</p> <p>Consider the most appropriate geographical area.</p>	
Visits	<p>Arrange to visit a residential accommodation service, meet the service provider, house manager/facilitator and residents.</p> <p>Develop an understanding of how a successful residence is run.</p>	
Review	<p>Review options.</p> <p>Consider the appropriateness of the proposed service, supporting activities and costs.</p>	
Make a decision	<p>Consider how the supported accommodation or living arrangements may be best arranged.</p> <p>Make a decision.</p>	
Set up accommodation	<p>Gather information and build understanding from the service provider and parents with the same needs or are using a service.</p>
